


When the lake level falls below 680 feet above mean sea level (680 feet msl), this area becomes land accessible to park visitors.



We've established the following to ensure a pleasant and safe visit:

1. Camping is permitted only in designated areas on LCRA land.
2. Only authorized vehicles are permitted in the parks and must remain on designated roads and parking areas. Special uses may be allowed.
3. Please drink responsibly.
4. Campfires are permitted only in designated fire rings or barbecue pits.
5. Hunting and trapping are not permitted.
6. Possession or discharge of any kind of fireworks or explosives is prohibited.
7. Swimming is permitted but not within 50 feet of any boat ramp. Swimming is at your own risk; there are no lifeguards. Portable swimming pools or slip 'n slides are prohibited.
8. Please clean up and properly dispose of all pet waste. Keep pets on leash in designated camping and picnicking areas; outside these areas, pets must be kept under their owner's direct control.
9. Respect quiet hours from 10 p.m.-6 a.m.
10. Thank you for not littering.
